



Women's Health and Cancer Rights Act

If you had or are going to have a mastectomy, you may be entitled to certain benefits under the Women's Health and Cancer Rights Act of 1998 (WHCRA). For individuals receiving mastectomy-related benefits, coverage will be provided in a manner determined in consultation with the attending physician and the patient, for:

- All Stages of reconstruction of the breast on which the mastectomy was performed.
- Surgery and reconstruction of the other breast to produce a symmetric appearance.
- Prosthesis; and
- Treatment of physical complications at all stages of the mastectomy, including lymphedemas, in a manner determined in consultation with the attending physician and the patient.

The coverage may be subject to coinsurance and deductibles consistent with those established for other benefits.
